Up Our Road celebrates and documents community champions with a story of migration and connection to Oswald and Frodingham Road. North Lincolnshire Museum sits within one of the most diverse neighbourhoods in North Lincolnshire. The stretch of road is home to community centres, churches of different denominations, businesses, restaurants, a gurdwara and mosques. Through personal interviews and photographic portraits, Up Our Road documents the experiences and stories of people who work to strengthen their communities. The exhibition highlights stories of leadership and contribution from across the community, including Roj Rahman, co-owner of Scunthorpe United Football Club.
